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Elementary Cell Phone and Electronics Policy

All telecommunication devices and headphones/earbuds should be powered off and kept in the students' backpacks. In accordance with the 2023-2024 BISD student handbook, "The district permits students to possess personal cell phones, smart watches, and other telecommunications devices for safety purposes; **however**, these devices must remain **turned off** during the instructional day, including during all testing, unless they are being used for **approved** instructional purposes."

If communication is needed, it should be carried out through the main office. Students will be allowed to check their devices once a day before traveling to lunch.

The student or parent may pick up the confiscated telecommunications device from the main office for a fee of \$15."
