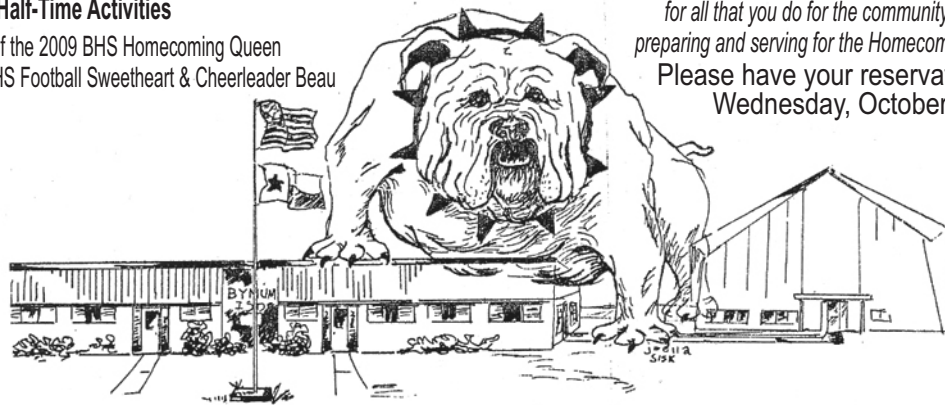

So many wonderful things have been happening at Bynum. We are a TEA RECOGNIZED District! I congratulate the faculty, staff and students for this honor and recognize all of their hard work.

Other progress is made with our financial rating from the state, in that we are rated Above Standard Achievement this year with our FIRST (Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas) Report. Bynum scored 73, which is only 2 points away from Superior Achievement. We are on our way!

On the Federal side of education, Bynum School met AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress). This means academically we met the federal government standards.

Our enrollment is around 235 to being the year. The first several weeks of school we expect a few more students to come and we are ready for them! Our volleyball teams and football teams are working hard to get ready for the seasons. We have 19 young men playing football this year which means we have a JV and a varsity team. How exciting is that? There are eleven young ladies on the volleyball team this year and they have already started their games.
