Required every day

Pencils with good erasers Marking pens (flair or colored ball point) or highlighters 100 page "composition" notebook

No Spirals, binders, or folders! Most students only need one composition book for the year, but if you have large handwriting, you might prefer two. Graph paper, blank, college and wide ruled are all acceptable. It is your choice.

Do not spend a lot of money on fancy notebooks, because we will decorate the cover.

Optional

Graphing calculator

I support TI-81 through 84 plus cs and Ti-nspire CS Graphing calculators with a CAS system or a TI-89 are not permitted

You may use HP or Casio, but I do not know the menus well and we will have to learn together.

I provide calculators in class, so there is no need to own one, unless you really want your own.

Every student gets a chromebook, and **Desmos** is the *online calculator* we use in class for projects and activities when graphs need to be complex and we want to see motion. All students have access to this platform at home with their chromebook, *it is free*, and it is "better" than any hand held calculator I have ever used.
